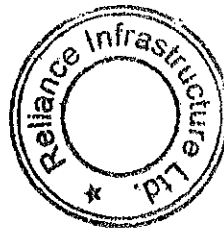

LARGEST URBAN INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT IN INDIA

THE 17.17-KM VERSOVA-BANDRA SEA LINK PROJECT IS TO BE COMMISSIONED IN 5 YEARS

Mumbai, September 04, 2018: Reliance Infrastructure Limited - Astaldi S.p.A (Italy) Consortium signed an agreement with Maharashtra State Road Development Corporation (MSRDC) today for construction of prestigious Versova-Bandra Sea Link Project in Mumbai.

Reliance Infrastructure - Astaldi had earlier bagged the engineering, procurement and construction (EPC) contract for the Rs. 7,000 crore project on a competitive bid basis. The consortium had emerged the most competitive bidder with their bid of Rs. 6,993.99 crore. The other bidders in fray were L&T-Samsung and Hyundai Development Company-ITD.

The tender for the construction of second sea link in Mumbai on EPC-basis was floated by MSRDC. With a length of 17.17 km, Versova-Bandra Sea Link is three times the length of the existing Bandra-Worli Sea Link, which is 5.6 km.

Speaking on the occasion, Reliance Infrastructure Limited EPC CEO, Arun Gupta, said, ***“We are very proud of having won this prestigious project, one of its kind in India. This project will further propel Reliance Infrastructure as a premier EPC Company in India. Our partnership with Astaldi S.p.A, the third biggest construction player in the world in bridges, will help us create a truly world class mega infrastructure project for Mumbai.”***

Reliance Infrastructure - Astaldi has to commission the project in 5 years from the appointed date. However, owing to monsoons, the work would be completely stalled for three months

each year. Therefore, the consortium will effectively have just over three and a half years to complete the complex project.

Reliance Infrastructure's partner in the project, Astaldi S.p.A, is world's third largest player in bridge construction. The largest order executed by them is Izmit Bay Bridge (Gebze-Orhangazi-Izmir Motorway Project) in Turkey with US\$7b (Rs. 45,500 crore) investment for the entire project. It is the fourth longest suspension bridge worldwide that was completed in April 2016.

Besides, Astaldi has also executed the Western High Speed Diameter Motorway in Saint Petersburg in Russia with Euro 2.2b (Rs. 17,600 crore) contract value. The project has a 12-km section with 5.3-km viaducts on sea and two cable stay bridges, which was opened to the traffic in December 2016.
